OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST

SCHOOL SETTING

POSITION SUMMARY: Organizes and conducts occupational therapy programs in the school setting to assist each student to achieve their fullest potential physically and prevent progression of any disability.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Provide evaluation, program development and treatment to all students appropriate for occupational therapy services.
2. Monitor, fabricate and adapt splints, orthotics, casts and adaptive equipment as appropriate.
3. Attend team meetings as needed to determine appropriate placement, modify programs, report on student's progress, etc.
4. Provide consultation and training to staff, parents and volunteers for occupational therapy programs as needed.
5. Assist in development of IEP's/IFSP's and make recommendations to team regarding occupational therapy by school's established deadline.
6. Consultant for supported home service providing evaluation and treatments to homebound population.
7. Attend appropriate conferences and continuing education courses to further develop skills.
